

**PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE MESSAGE CAREFULLY**  
**BEFORE CALLING THE OFFICE**

Finally.... We have received a very limited supply of H1N1 injectable vaccine. There is no H1N1 mist available. We will be able to hold only **1** clinic at our Kennesaw office on Saturday, December 12<sup>th</sup> from 8:30am-12:30pm by **Appointment Only**. Please call Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup> and Wednesday, December 2<sup>nd</sup> from 8:30-12:30 to schedule your appointment. We will have designated staff members to make the appointments at these times to improve efficiency. Please **Do Not** request an appointment online. We will only be accepting appointments by phone during the assigned times. The vaccine is available for children ages 6 months through 2 years (35 months) and 4 years and above. At this time we have received no H1N1 vaccine for children 3 years old (36 months through 47 months). Unfortunately, we have **NO CONTROL** over the type of vaccine that is sent to us. Please **Do Not** call the office for an appointment if your child is 3 years old. We will send out another email as soon as we receive another shipment with exact details.

We will not be administering any booster or 2<sup>nd</sup> doses to children who have received the first vaccine elsewhere due to the small size of our shipment. We recommend you check the following website to search for locations that has H1N1 available for booster doses: [www.health.state.ga.us](http://www.health.state.ga.us) and search by zip code and mile radius.

We are following the CDC's guidelines to vaccinate children from 6 months through 20 years of age with or without chronic illnesses. Please visit [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov) if you have questions.

No other vaccines will be given at this visit. If your child is sick the day of your appointment, you will need to come in as a

walk in and have your child seen by a provider prior to getting the vaccine.

Please have all insurance information on hand when you call to schedule. If you have new insurance, be prepared to give the information to our billing department. If you do not have insurance, there will be a \$21.00 administration fee. Once you have scheduled your appointment, please go to our website at [www.eastcobbped.com](http://www.eastcobbped.com) and click the **Flu Resources** tab. Print the H1N1 Consent Form and fill out sections 1-4. Bring this with you the day of your appointment. If you cannot print the form, come to the Kennesaw or Marietta office to pick up and fill out the form. Bring this with you to the Kennesaw office the day of your appointment.

Please remember that the government is only sending us small shipments, so we will run out of appointments. We will send out another email as soon as we receive the next shipment. We understand that this is a stressful time and will continue to keep you updated on all information as we receive it.
